- Treasurer, Cindy O'Brien has exciting news; she has been working on several items with the help of her husband John. She has now set up an online payment option with the app *Square*. You can access this option by visiting our website (link on front page of newsletter). To pay dues for our club you can access it on the home page under the "contact" tab. There is also a link for the MCA website on the home page to sign up for the MCA or to pay your MCA dues. When the registration becomes available for our shows there will be a QR Code to scan for easy registration and payment. She has also has updated our Club's non-profit status; with the non-profit status she was able to get a discount when signing up for *Square*.
- Diane Geul gave an update on the breakfast and lunches. This Saturday the 8th is at Fa-Ray's in Barberton. There is space available. On March 19th lunch is at Noble House in Hudson, recommended by Marina; this venue is full unless she has cancellations. Breakfast at Lukity's in Akron on March 8th
