March 20th (Thursday) lunch is at Sully's Irish Pub in Medina; breakfast April 5th at Samantha's on Portage St. and lunch on April 16th at Sweet Henries in Norton.  - Diane has arranged for a day trip on Saturday, May 17th to the Ohio Caverns. There are 3 tours available. The Limestone tour is about 1/2 an hour and is good for those with limited mobility.
